- 1. The meeting was called to Order at 8:30 pm by the Clerk.
- 2. Flag Pledge
- 3. Election Results:

- 5. Bobbie Germanson moved to accept the Agenda as written, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Emily Lanin. All in favor, motion passed.
- 6. Motion by Chris Hewitt to approve the Minutes of the 2018 Annual Meeting; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Bobbie Germanson. All in favor, motion passed.
- 7. The 2018 Treasurer's Report was read by Treasurer Shirley Weyer. Mabel Kelby moved to accept the report as read, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ann Stafford, all approved, motion carried.
- 8. The Clerk read the Board of Audit Report. The Board verified the total receipts for 2018 were \$336,459.90 and total disbursements were \$240,299.45. Receipts and claims were randomly reviewed and verified by the three supervisors.
- Rick Hennes, Road Supervisor, gave a summary Road Report. Roads are in excellent Shape after graveling. Maintenance is watching for frozen culverts and washouts this spring.

## 10. Levy Discussion:

Handouts of the budget for 2019 and 2020, past years levies, receipts, & expenses, and considerations for the 2020 Levy were reviewed and discussed.
